

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

Zoom Microsoft Teams Facebook Google Classroom

Zoom: How has it been used?

Commonly used virtual platform

Used for various employment programs

Used to safely hold meetings with large groups



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Microsoft Teams: How has it been used?

Used to connect with staff virtually

Entire staff form a "Team"

Contains a chat & video function

Can edit & share documents

Easy to pass on information to all staff



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Facebook Messenger/Video Chat



Used to connect with clients individually

Used for check-ins when in person check-ins cannot be completed

Allows for the connection to the program participants to continue

Facebook Groups

Create private groups with participants

Facebook Live used for instructions

Participants can review videos on their own time

Google Classroom

Free web service used for virtual instruction

Used to create, distribute, and grade assignments

Allows for education to continue virtually

Google Calendar automatically updated to keep individuals on track

Connects with other apps to modify programming

MeMinder

Online Job Portals

Communication Supports

Time Timer

Allows user to create timers

Keeps them on task

Creates smooth transitions

Free on Android and Apple devices



MeMinder

Commonly used by individuals with varying abilities

Talking pictures to-do list and video modeling tool

Tasks can be modified for each user to help with productivity

Users can indicate when a task is complete



Online Job Portals

Virtual job searching has become the new normal

Resumes submitted online

Entire interview process has commonly been virtual

Barriers exist for some individuals using these platforms
